

The almond branch is not a random symbol—it is a **thread through the whole Bible**:

- In **Numbers**, it is the first blossom of priesthood.
- In **Jeremiah**, it is God's assurance that He is watching.
- In Hebrews and the Gospels, it points to Jesus, the final High Priest.
- In the **resurrection**, it shows Him as the first blossom of eternal life.

The almond is God's reminder: He is watching, He is faithful, His priesthood is alive, and His Word will blossom in due season.
